If you're patient, energetic but strict when needed, we'd like to meet you!*

Escort and oversee campers at all times [exception – when campers are residing at designated facilities]	Higher education, minimum bachelor's and / teaching experience.
You will supervise and educate campers (ages 9-14) in the history of space, creativity, teamwork and leadership.	Experience working with children, or with specific activities is preferred.
Provide knowledgeable explanations about a variety of space related subjects and perform lectures/briefings as assigned.	First aid, CPR training is preferred.
Working with other crew team leaders to plan and coordinate camp activities – cultural and educational.	Physical ability to participate in activities, run, climb, swim, lift, or support the weight of kids.
Educate campers through games and exploration.	Arabic and English language proficiency.
Leading and supporting campers as they participate in age-appropriate activities.	Being reliable and able to build good relationships with children.
Escort and accompany campers [as required] to scheduled activities, maintaining orderly behavior and a professional learning environment.	Ability to pass a background check.
Monitoring campers to ensure compliance with camp rules and prevent accidents.	High level of responsibility and accountability and upbeat and engaging personality.
Reporting and recording details of incidents, such as accidents or rule violations, to camp directors.	Strong communication, interpersonal, and leadership skills.
Memorizing all emergency procedures and enforcing camp rules.	Availability for full program dates on residential capacity.
Participating in staff meetings.	USA Visa Required - no travel restrictions.

### Ideal Candidate

We prefer applicants be least 19 years of age (exemptions may be made based on leadership experience) and have completed at least 20 hours of college credit or applicable life/professional experience.

Experience working with children (such as coaching, tutoring or teaching) is desired.

Previous camp, space exploration, education or instructional work experience is a plus.

Applicants must exhibit strong leadership skills and possess excellent communication skills.

### How to Apply

The application process begins here where you will be directed to upload your resume and answer a questionnaire. If selected, you will be contacted to set up an interview.
