

ON WRITING WELL: Tips

- Telling details ie. Evidence the details selected that will make a difference those details that will help the audience learn something
- Draw good conclusions we all may have the same evidence but we will all have different ideas on what conclusions to draw based on all of those things that make us who we are.
- Get the reader into some spot into your brain your writing is going to someone "will it make sense to them?.."
- Know your audience think of individual readers rather than mass audiences.
- Ethos Logos Pathos > from Aristotle > in order to get any message across to people -
 - It needs to be logical
 - Should have emotional appeal
 - You must get your audience to trust you
- Systematic organization : telling a story; narrative structure -- / assertion with reason/ assertion with evidence
